The Company Formation

- Nzoia Water Services Company Limited (Nzowasco) was formed under the Companies Act (CAP 486) on 4th February 2004 and became operational a year later on 9th February 2005.
- The Company's mandate is to provide water and sewerage services within the County Governments of Bungoma (Bungoma &Chwele, Webuye & Kimilili) and Trans Nzoia (Kitale).
- The company is co-owned by the two County Governments; Trans Nzoia and Bungoma.

Notes:

- The company's cumulative Design Capacity stands at 48,500 m³/d, however, the current actual cumulative production capacity is at 32,950m³/d.
- This is due to slow expansion of our water network systems to accommodate optimal production.
- There is need to carry out expansion of our network systems to be able to operate at optimum plant capacity.

Reasons for increased dormant accounts

>Customers inability to service water bills

Areas affected by demolitions, road construction and railway rehabilitation

Collapsed industries e.g. pan paper,

Sewerage Services

- ➤ Sewerage Coverage stands at 31%
- ➤ We also partner with Private exhausters who are authorized to conduct these services after paying a monthly fee to the Company.
- ➤ Sewerage Services are offered to Bungoma County
 Webuye and Kitale (Matisi and Bidii ponds) regions

Non-Revenue Water

NRW is water that is supplied but does not generate revenue for the Company as a result of the following:

- ➤ Meter tampering
- > Illegal connections
- ➤ Leakages & Bursts
- ➤ Meter under-reading
- ➤ Data handling errors



Illegal Connection

Causes for Non Revenue Water

- > Leakage and bursts are major problem
- ➤ Water theft is rampant across the cluster leading to both loss of water and revenue.
- ➤ Old dilapidated infrastructure (AC pipes) that are not compatible with the current technology are also a source of NRW.
- > Destruction of pipes by the various contractors in both Counties.

Water Quality Assurance

- > Our produced water is of good quality because it meets the WASREB standards > 98% of the Benchmark
- We undertake internal bacteriological and physical tests on a daily basis to ensure that water produced complies with quality standards.
- The company regularly carries out water quality surveillance tests along the distribution network and designated consumer points.
- ➤ We conduct quarterly water and waste water quality analysis tests at certified external labs. These results are shared with our regulatory bodies and NEMA.



Pro-poor initiatives;

- NZOWASCO has made initiatives to reach Low Income Areas (LIA) through extension of water and sanitation.
- These areas largely comprise of unplanned urban settlements, characterized by limited access to water and sanitation.
- ➤ Projects carried in these areas, are largely funded by WSTF. The projects have seen construction of improved toilet facilities at plot level and public sanitation facilities(PSF).
- The Company has so far constructed 3 public sanitation facilities in Chwele, Kitale and Kanduyi.
- The company partnering with WSTF made efforts to expand sanitation services by constructing 600 plot level sanitation facilities in Low income areas (300 Bungoma and 300 in Kitale Town).
- ➤ The Company is currently undertaking construction of one PSF in Bungoma Town and 8.65 km water line extension and a Water kiosk in Kitale Town.

Projects & Partnerships

- > The company recently completed the following projects:
 - ❖ Waitaluk Amagoro Kapkoi water extension line
 - * Rotich-Maliki Water extension line
 - ❖ Sikata –Lusaka road Water extension line
- ➤ So far the Rotich and Amagoro lines have 30 new connections, we project 500 connections by the end of the year.
- ➤ Joint projects with LVNWWDA and the County Government of Bungoma are; KOICA I completed and operating and KOICA II which is being developed.
- > County Government Trans-Nzoia in terms of infrastructure development of KIPTOGOT-KOLONGOLO water project.

Corporate Social Responsibility

➤ In partnership with LVNWWDA, NZOWASCO was able to offer 58 Tanks and Sanitizers to the public to curb Covid 19





Human Resource and Administration

➤ Staffing — Total staff -279

➤ P & P and long contracts -191

> Short contracts (6 months) - 88

Challenges

- ➤ Vandalization of service lines especially during road construction
- ➤ Non payment of water bills by Government institutions.
- Theft of water meters gate valves and sewer manhole covers
- Lack of co-ordination in physical planning wayleave for pipelines
- ➤ Water theft by customers
- ➤ Old pipeline network causing water losses
- > Inadequate investments
- ➤ Weather patterns affecting Treatment plants in terms of siltation and water levels



Challenges cont'd

- ➤ Political interference e.g Chesikaki leading to high NRW&loss of revenue.
- Lack of funds to renovate the treatment works.
- ➤ High cost of production: increased chemical usage due to high turbidity at the abstraction points.
- ➤ High power bills for two stage pumping stations: Matisi, Nzoia and Nabuyole in Webuye.
- ➤ Limited number of vehicles to reach our expansive network especially during emergency

Recommendations

- Financial support from the County government of Bungoma and Trans-Nzoia to meet production input costs
- > The Government institutions to pay their water bills and arrears.
- Consultative meeting for planning, implementation and planning of water and sanitation projects
- ➤ Joint implementation of projects which affect water network e.g. road construction
- ➤ Water and sewer network expansion and upgrading to accommodate the increasing demand
